

2016-2017 Community and Student Engagement (CaSE)

The Texas Education Code (TEC) requires all districts and charters to evaluate their own performance, as well as that of each of their campuses, in community and student engagement. Schools must assign one of four performance ratings: Exemplary, Recognized, Acceptable or Unacceptable.

In addition to an overall rating, districts assign to themselves and to each of their campuses a performance rating for the following categories:

- Fine Arts
- Wellness and Physical Education
- Community and Parental Involvement
- 21st Century Workforce Development Program
- Second Language Acquisition Program
- Digital Learning Environment
- Dropout Prevention Strategies
- Educational Programs for Gifted and Talented Students (not required in charters)

After considering all of the above categories, the Campus Leadership Committee assigned La Academia de Estrellas Charter School an overall rating of “Acceptable” for Community and Student Engagement.

Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year, CaSE ratings will no longer be required.
